Displacement-Affected Communities in Social Protection

A planned research series on displacement-affected communities and social protection: what it would examine, and how.

WHAT THIS DOCUMENT COVERS

- 01 Who the systems register**
A line of inquiry into how displacement-affected households currently appear, or do not appear, in registration and targeting records.
- 02 Targeting and mobility**
An examination of how residency-based targeting rules interact with households that move, and what that implies for eligibility.
- 03 The delivery step**
Planned fieldwork on what happens between an entitlement being recorded and a household actually receiving it.
- 04 Consent and data protection**
A section on how personal data on displaced people is collected, stored and shared, and the safeguards that should govern it.
- 05 Factsheet design**
Work on presenting the evidence as short interactive factsheets that a programme officer can read in ten minutes.

STATUS

This document is in preparation. Veynuus publishes research only once the underlying fieldwork, data and review are complete, so no findings are presented here. This file records the scope and intent of the work and will be replaced by the full publication on release.
